By forming a Friday Night Live Club at a school or community center, the core group impacts the entire school population and surrounding community with activities throughout the year:

- ✓ Clubs usually meet weekly
- ✓ Leadership trainings are more in depth about alcohol, tobacco and other drug and related issues, and what environmental prevention strategies reduce use in the community.
- ✓ Activities, Skill Building and Opportunities help earn community service hours and provide Service Learning Projects. These also help with academic achievement, and prepare youth for college.
